As for the online learning media is Google Meet, Google is providing video conferences for everyone with a Google account. You can create online learning with up to 100 participants, and each meeting can hold up to one hour. As an attempt to improve the level of education, it is often carried out in various ways. Among other things, by perfecting the e-learning process that has been completed. Therefore, the educator must evaluate his learning so that he knows what changes must be made. Students and teachers are those who participate in the learning process so that they also understand the methods and results of learning activities. RESULT AND DISCUSSION

The teacher assesses students in the google meeting well, the teacher assesses attendance, assignments and daily tests, the teacher's assessment in the google meeting is very clear and accurate because the teacher assesses students directly during the google meet. It is supported by Vivin Nur Wahyuni 2021 "Google Meet can also be used for the process of evaluating student attitudes, such as when students submit ideas, thoughts, opinions or questions related to the material presented by the teacher. "

The teacher used an oral test in the assessment of learning through the Google Meet application. The oral test assessment technique is a learning outcome assessment technique in which questions and answers are delivered verbally and spontaneously. In the assessment using an oral test the teacher assesses students accurately. Teachers can find out directly the ability of students one by one.

The teacher's assessing student learning achievement through the google meet application is first, the teacher assesses student attendance during learning, student attendance is one of the factors that become student assessments at school, not only one of the assessment criteria, but also used as determinant of student graduation. The second, teachers judged from the results of student assignments, whether students were diligent in doing assignments or not, the third was the student's daily test, this daily test was carried out by an oral test by the teacher through the google meet application. This daily test was conducted to determine the level of understanding of each student in understanding the learning material.
